## Brookside Elementary School

## **P.E.**

P.E. will be held twice a week. Your child's teacher will notify you when his or her PE days will be. On these days, please make sure your child has appropriate clothes/shoes. Tennis shoes are required. Pants, shorts, sweats, and comfortable tops are good PE clothes. Loose fitting, baggy clothing is not appropriate. Shoes with heels, slippery bottoms, or open backs are unsafe. Kids who are not dressed in appropriate PE clothing will not be able to participate that day. If your child "forgets" PE days easily, consider leaving a pair of tennis shoes and/or a change of clothes at school. It is expected that each child

will participate in each PE class unless indicated by a parent or doctor note. If your child is unable to participate due to illness or injury, please provide a note for the teacher stating what he/she is/is not able to do.
