Dear Kellogg Families:

Kellogg provides a variety of academic support through programs such as Hang Time homework help (after school Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays), peer tutoring support, specialized classes for WASL writing and math, the Read to Achieve (Read 180) program, and tutorial classes. We also know that sometimes students may just need a little more time during school hours.

Starting in January with a few teachers, and expanding in February 2009, teachers will be referring students to our new Homework Lunch Program. A referral will be filled out when a student has not completed their homework and students will eat their lunch and work on homework completion in a supervised class environment. This is meant to be a supportive intervention because we know that students feel more successful when they do not fall behind in their work.
