## Grade 1

### 2009 - 2010 Student School Supply List

Below is a list, by grade level, of school supplies your child needs to bring on the first day of school.

**Please label all your child's supplies with his or her name (unless otherwise instructed below).**

**When there is a certain brand of supply requested, please try to purchase that brand if possible. Certain brands work more effectively and produce higher quality student work.**

There will be a few additional supplies purchased by the 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders during the first week of school.

4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>: Notebook dividers (8 in a pack) \$1.00

5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades: School planner \$5.00

**Teachers may request additional supplies throughout the school year.**

### All-Day Kindergarten

#### Community materials, do not label

- 1 4-ounce bottle **Elmer's** white glue (not colored)
- 8 glue sticks
- 1 box **Crayola** wide markers
- 1 box **Crayola** size "Large" crayons (8 color set)
- 1 box **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 1 box **Crayola** water color paints (8 color set)
- 2 boxes crackers or pretzels
- 1 large eraser

The following supplies should be clearly labeled:

- 1 roomy waterproof backpack (2 shoulder strap)
- 2 folders (bottom pocket)
- 1 pair of **Fiskars** scissors (metal blade, not plastic)

If convenient, you may bring these items to the classrooms when you come for the Back to School Barbecue and Kindergarten Open House before school starts.

### Half-Day Kindergarten

Label with child's name:

- 1 roomy waterproof backpack – regular size, big enough to fit an 8 1/2" x 11" plastic envelope (two shoulder straps)

**DO NOT LABEL** as these are shared supplies:

- 2 boxes crackers or snacks
- 3 large glue sticks
- 1 box **Crayola** crayons (box of 24)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pair of **Fiskars** scissors (metal blade, not plastic)
- 1 4-ounce bottle **Elmer's** white glue (not colored)

#### Use permanent marker to label your name on these items

- 1 backpack or book bag
- 1 pair of **Fiskars** scissors
- 2 PeeChee-type folder with **bottom** pockets
- 1 plastic school/pencil box (**8" x 4.5" x 2"**)
- 1 pencil sharpener with attached container for shavings
- 2 boxes **Crayola** wide tip markers \*\*
- 1 box **Crayola** colored pencils (1 zipped pouch for storage)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 box crayons (**16 colors maximum**)
- 12 **large** glue sticks \*\*

- 2 full size box facial tissues \*\*
- 2 pump bottle of **Liquid Soap** \*\*
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox sanitizing wipes (70/75ct)
- 1 Costco sized snack to share with the class
- 1 Sticky note pad
- Stickers (for correcting papers – any style is fine as long as it is appropriate for elementary age students)

- 1 box crayons (24 colors max)
- 1 box **Crayola** wide tip markers
- 1 box **Crayola** colored pencils
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 **full** size box facial tissues
- 1 bottle **Elmer's** white glue (4oz.)
- 32 solid glue sticks
- 1 pair **Fiskars** scissors
- 2 pump bottles of liquid soap
- 1 bottle of Lysol or Clorox sanitizing wipes

- 1 pair **Fiskars** scissors
- 1 ruler with inch and metric markings
- 1 box of crayons (at least 16 colors)
- 1 box of colored pencils (at least 16 colors)
- 3 spiral-bound wide-rule notebook
- 2 ream wide-ruled notebook paper
- 3 report folders with brads and pockets (green, blue, yellow one each)
- 1 container of anti-bacterial all-purpose wipes (flip top lid)
- 1 box facial tissues
- 1 ream of lined paper
- 1 set dry erase markers

## Grade 5

(\*particular to Ms. Palmer's class)

- 1 large 3-ring binder (**no Trapper Keepers**)
- \*3 composition books, wide-ruled
- 3 packages #2 pencils (at least 20 pencils) **sharpened**
- 1 container of sanitizing wipes

- 1 pair adult scissors

- Colored pencils
- 200 page package wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 red pens
- 1 highlighter any color
- 2 8-1/2" x 11" **spiral-bound notebooks, wide-ruled paper**, at least 70 page

- small protractor (translucent) and a compass
