Dear Parent and Current 8th Grade Student:

On behalf of Shorecrest High School, I would like to inform you of the upcoming registration process for the 2009-2010 school year, and invite you to 8th Grade Parent Night on Tuesday, February 24, 2009. Registration is an important event in a student's transition from middle to high school, and as such, we encourage you to review and participate in this process.

Tuesday, February 24: 8th Grade Parent Night

This event is aimed primarily at parents, but 8th grade students are also welcome to attend.

Here is your chance to meet the administrators, counselors, and staff members of Shorecrest High School. The focus will be on curricular planning and the registration process for the 2009-2010 school year. There are several components to the evening:

- **6:00 – 6:45 PM: Student-led tours of the Shorecrest campus**, Foyer (main entrance)
These tours will be a brief introduction to the services and facilities available at Shorecrest. Tours running 15-25 minutes will depart as needed during this time.
- **6:15 – 6:50 PM: Directed Studies – Parent Information Meeting**, room B8
For parents of students with IEPs. An overview of the Shorecrest Directed Studies program, and answers to questions you may have.
- **6:15 – 6:50 PM: Honors – Parent Information Meeting**, Shorecrest Library
For parents of students interested in the Shorecrest Honors program. An overview of the Shorecrest Honors program and curriculum, and answers to questions you may have.
- **7:00 PM: 8th Grade Parent Registration/Information Meeting & Open House**, SC Theater
Shorecrest staff will discuss the academic program and the registration process. Following the meeting in the Theater (at approximately 7:45 PM), an Open House will be held in the Shorecrest Cafeteria area. Department representatives and Shorecrest guidance counselors will be available to answer specific questions and provide additional information. There will also be information about student activities and clubs.
- **7:45 – 8:15 PM: Student-led tours of the Shorecrest campus** (see above for description)

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KELLOGG MIDDLE SCHOOL 8th GRADERS

Tuesday/Wednesday, February 24/25: Kellogg 8th graders receive registration materials

Registration orientations, presented by Shorecrest counselors, will be held during students' English classes. Students will receive all necessary registration materials at that time. Registration information, the Registration Guide, and forms will also be available online at www.shorelineschools.org/shorecrest/registration .

Monday, March 9: Kellogg Registration pick-up

Registration forms are due back to Kellogg. These forms must be signed by the parent and the student; if the student has an IEP, the IEP manager must also sign.

ROOM 9 COMMUNITY SCHOOL 8th GRADERS

A Shorecrest counselor will visit the school in early March to distribute registration information and forms, and at that time will provide the date for return of the forms. These forms must be signed by the parent and the student; if the student has an IEP, the IEP manager must also sign.

8th GRADERS NOT CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A SHORELINE DISTRICT SCHOOL



**ALL 8th GRADERS WHO RESIDE OUT-OF-DISTRICT,
OR WHO RESIDE IN THE DISTRICT BUT WEST OF INTERSTATE 5**

New boundary exception applications are required for ALL students entering Shorecrest High School who reside outside the Shorecrest attendance area (which is that portion of ZIP Code 98155 which falls on the East side of Interstate 5). Once a Shorecrest boundary exception is approved, a release must be obtained annually from the resident school district.
