Opening School 2011-2012

Dear Thunderbirds:

We're looking forward to seeing you in late September for the 2011-2012 school year! Please read the information below carefully to be informed of the details regarding the opening of school:

9th Grade Transition to High School: Wednesday, September 7th 7:50-11:50 AM Freshman and New Student Orientation.

Ninth graders, new students in all grades and Link Crew members attend school 7:50-11:50 AM. Transportation will not be provided. New Student/Freshman and Parent PTSA barbecue 5:30-6:30 PM. Parent orientation program from 6:45-8:00 PM in the gymnasium.

Class Schedule and i-Pad Distribution for all students prior to school opening – Tuesday (grade 12), Wednesday (grade 11), Thursday (grade 9) and Friday (grade 10), September 6-9, 12:00-3:30PM: All students should plan to come to campus for ID pictures, purchase of ASB cards and annuals, i-Pad distribution, updated class schedules and schedule adjustments. Photos and ASB business needs to be complete before the student can get a schedule and check out an I-pad. Counselors are available for schedule adjustments in the Library for juniors and seniors only. Freshman and sophomore schedules will only be changed in order to meet graduation or other post-secondary education requirements. **A detailed schedule of appointments will be published in mid-August. Fees and overdue fines must be paid in full. See page two for details.**

Classes in Session- All Students, Grades 9-12, Monday, September, 12th:

Students should plan to pick up their schedules, i-pads and photo ID before school opens. Students should go directly to their first period class on the first day of school. The first three days' schedule will be all "C" days Monday, September 12th- Wednesday, September 14th periods 1-6 7:50 am – 2:25 pm. Students who did not pick up their schedules before school will need to pick up schedules in the SAC and have ID pictures taken when they arrive at school on September 12th.

Fall Open House and Curriculum Night Tuesday, September 27, 2010, 7:00PM: Please join us to meet your student's teachers, to hear about the course of study and learn about ways for parents to partner with the school.

Fall Athletics Try-outs: Athletic forms must be turned in to the Shorewood Business Office before turning out. Football turn-out is Wednesday, August 17th (freshmen included). All other sports begin Monday, August 22nd: Students cannot participate in athletics until the required forms and proof of insurance have been turned in to the Shorewood Business Office. Forms are available in a container outside the main office all summer.

Shorewood Business Office On-Line: Speed through the lines prior to school... Starting August 15th, you may choose to pay for your student's expenses by credit card in advance online. Please see the school's main page for the link to on-line payment. Signed forms must be brought to the school in person. The Shorewood Business Office will open for payment in person beginning August 15. Unpaid fees, lost materials and library books assessed during previous school years must be resolved before a schedule or i-pad will be issued.

What's it all cost? (Note: Please plan to write one check for all school business except spirit items and Dorian photos.)

1. **ID Picture: Free** (Required for school security) – Students may order portrait photos directly from Dorian Studios. *Please bring a check made out to Dorian for this purpose.*
2. **Annual Technology Insurance Fees** There will be a \$45 insurance fee for each I-pad including a protective case.
3. **ASB Card** (Optional) –\$30. 00 (Picture is not optional.) Because all music groups, sports teams, and clubs are funded by ASB cards, all members of these groups are required to purchase a card. Students who need financial assistance for ASB, Yearbook, or Sports Fee should request assistance through their counselor. You can save over \$200 on school activities by using your ASB card such as yearbooks, and all home sports events.
4. **Annual** (Optional) – The first sale period is August 15 through September 10 at a discounted rate of \$60 with ASB **card**, or \$65 without. The yearbook will be available for \$75 for two sale periods in December and June.
5. **SW Pride items will be available from Boosters and ASB** –eg. Kelly Green, Royal Blue or White T-shirt is \$10 and Tie-dyed T-shirt is \$15. Shorewood water bottles are \$5. Shorewood stickers are \$3. *Please bring separate cash or check for these items.*
6. **Athletic Participation Fees:** The following fees must be paid **after cuts are made** and prior to the first competition: 1) \$100.00 Athletic Participation Fee per sport; 2) Purchase of a \$30.00 ASB sticker for student I.D. card.

Other Business:

1. **Locker and parking sign-ups** (Optional)– Lockers will be assigned on the class schedule and will be assigned for four years. Parking permits will be issued after the start of school through the security office. Parking fees are \$25 for the school year.
2. **Informed Consent Form** – This is a two-part form which must be completed and returned if you wish to deny release of student information to organizations/individuals, and/or want your student's name withheld from the student directory and other publishable materials. This form must be completed and returned every year. Due date is October 1.
3. **Notice of Student Publicity:** From time to time during the year, the school publicizes various student achievements, awards and events. Please let the Front Office know if you do not want us to use an image of your child (photo and/or videotape) for internal and external publicity. Publicity may include both print and electronic publishing (internet and Channel 26, the district's local access channel).
